### FOLLOW IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF CHRIST



The great fifty-day celebration of Easter has concluded, as have the feasts honoring the Holy Trinity and the Body and Blood of Christ. Last week we began a long stretch of Ordinary Time that will bring us to late November. Saint Paul tells us today that those who are baptized “have clothed themselves with Christ” (Galatians 3:27). This scripture is echoed in the Church’s baptism ritual when we sing, “You have put on Christ, in Him you have been baptized.” This message is inspiring and sobering at the same time, for in today’s Gospel, we get to the heart of what it means to be clothed in Christ. The Lord tells us, “If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow Me” (Luke 9:23). For the next twenty-two weeks we are called to take up the cross and, with Saint Luke as our guide, follow in the footsteps of Christ.

The 2011 MASS BOOK will open **Thursday, June 24<sup>th</sup>, from 9 A.M. to 3 P.M.** It is only for parishioners who come to the Rectory. *PHONE REQUESTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.* We ask that you please fill out a Mass Request form **at home** before you come to the rectory. You can also mail in your requests. Mail will not be opened until June 24. These forms can be found in the back of church. Church law forbids us to accept more Mass intentions than we can fulfill in one year. Once this book is filled, we cannot accept additional Masses for the year 2011. Everyone, of course, prefers that their Masses be celebrated on Sunday. In order to be fair to the parishioners who want to schedule weekend Masses we will begin to limit the choices of the number of weekend Masses and the time that the Masses are offered during a month. Only one name on a weekend per month.. Only one name during the week (up to 4 names per month). These guidelines will give everyone the opportunity to choose a special date for Mass to be offered for their deceased loved ones. Your cooperation in this matter will be deeply appreciated. Archdiocesan policy dictates a \$10 offering for announced Masses. As always, if a person cannot afford a Mass offering and notifies us of that fact, we will honor his/her request.
